National Certified Food Safety Manager Class License

To obtain a National Certified Food Safety Manager License, you must pass a state-approved exam. The TLW class prepares you first, and then administers the exam the same day.

If you currently own a valid Wisconsin CFPM License and want to proceed with a Small Operator Permit, there are certain requirements you must meet, i.e., your license cannot be expired and you must employ five (5) or fewer total food handlers, including yourself.

Recent Wins:

Drinks To-Go

Led the effort to permit the sale of cocktails to-go from taverns, restaurants and supper clubs.

Consignments Changes

Successfully lobbied the Wisconsin Department of Revenue to permit the return of beer to wholesalers during the pandemic.

Liquor License Fee Reductions

Worked with various municipalities to reduce or waive Class B license renewal fees in 2020.

SafeRide Fee and TV Ad

Successfully lobbied for the creation of a SafeRide surcharge and use of SafeRide funds for TV ads promoting TLW SafeRide Program.

Operator License Procedure
